In preparation for this year's Annual Recognition Gala, please review the enclosed critical information regarding table purchases. The following Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) are meant to serve as a guide. Table Sales

How many tables can I purchase?

- In previous years, we have allowed companies to purchase up to 8 tables. However, in 2022, there is a maximum purchase of 3 tables.

Do you have different table purchase packages?

- Yes. We have three different options to choose from.
 - **Chairman: \$50,000**
 - **Platinum: \$40,000**
 - **Gold: \$35,000**

Once in the platform, be sure to check the box beside the option of your choice and type the number of tables you are purchasing in the box labeled "quantity."

Can I buy an individual ticket to the Gala?

- The ELC is not selling individual tickets at this time, with an exception only for ELC Legacy Members.

COVID-19 Information

As we prepare to convene in-person for The ELC's Annual Recognition Gala & Anniversary Celebration on October 6, 2022, we are prioritizing the health and safety of all ELC members and staff by employing the following precautions and protocols:

- Limiting ballroom capacity to 70% to allow for social distancing in the room
- Requiring all table purchases include the full legal names and contact information for all seated guests for contact tracing
- Requiring each Gala attendee is fully vaccinated
 - Fully vaccinated, as defined by The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), is two weeks after receiving all recommended doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna vaccines, or two weeks after the single-dose J&J/Janssen vaccine.
