The Executive Leadership Council's (ELC) Leadership Development Week (LDW) offers Black professionals the opportunity to develop themselves while leaving an indelible mark on corporate America in the process. LDW Course Descriptions

Bright Futures

Bright Futures is the flagship entry point for Leadership Development Week. It is designed specifically for new leaders or high potential early-in-career individuals who aspire to grow into future leadership roles within their organizations. This program places a strong emphasis on developing self-awareness, clarifying vision and goals, and cultivating strategic orientation, enabling participants to propel their careers forward with purpose and direction. Audience: This course is appropriate for high-potential non-people leaders on a leadership career track, first-time leaders, entry-level leaders, and early-in-career leaders.

Navigating the Corporate Landscape

A comprehensive and dynamic leadership development course designed for both mid-level leaders and experienced people leaders who aspire to understand what it takes to successfully navigate the corporate landscape. This program places a strong emphasis on developing self-awareness, self-management through emotional intelligence, strategic relationship building, strategic orientation, and industry awareness. This course is tailored to examine the Black experience in Corporate America and equip participants with the essential skills, knowledge, and mindsets necessary to survive, and thrive as leaders in today's dynamic business landscape. **Audience: This course is appropriate for mid-level leaders and experienced People Leaders, Project Leaders, and Program Leaders.**

Strategic Pathways for Women

Leading Innovation

Regardless of one's industry or sector, this course is ideal for ambitious leaders who are passionate about driving innovation and organizational transformation. This course focuses on establishing influence and credibility, understanding the impact of technologies like AI and social media on organizations, driving process improvements, and leading successful change management initiatives. Whether you are in a management role, aspiring to lead innovation initiatives, or seeking to be a catalyst of innovation and transformation, this program will provide valuable insights and tools. **Audience: This course is appropriate for mid-level leaders, business unit leaders, and experienced People Leaders, Project Leaders, and Program Leaders.**

Strengthening the Pipeline I

A dynamic and comprehensive leadership development experience designed to equip leaders with the necessary skills, abilities, and mindsets to successfully navigate their career progression and secure promotion to the next level. We accomplish this by identifying and utilizing individual skills to promote self-advocacy, developing strategic orientation, understanding industry awareness, building a personal brand, and fostering strategic relationships, this program empowers minority leaders with the skills necessary to accelerate one's leadership trajectory. This course is ideal for ambitious leaders seeking to identify and leverage their leadership skills to drive their career growth and success. **Audience: This course is appropriate for mid-level managers and experienced People Leaders, Project Leaders, and Program Leaders.**

Strengthening the Pipeline 2

An advanced leadership development experience tailored specifically for leaders who have already achieved significant leadership experience and are aiming for senior leadership positions within their organizations. This course is designed to equip participants with the necessary skills, abilities, and mindsets to strategically navigate their career advancement successfully and amplify their influence. Strengthening the Pipeline 2 focuses on identifying and leveraging leadership experience, increasing business acumen, fostering deep industry awareness, developing a leadership legacy, mastering leadership storytelling, and strategically networking through sponsorship. We utilize advanced case studies to address and understand the real-world business challenges faced by Black corporate leaders. **Audience: This course is appropriate for mid-level managers, business unit leaders, and Senior People Leaders, Project Leaders, and Program Leaders.**
